How does an Apprenticeship Work?

- 4 days a week are spent working for the employer
- Typically the apprentice will spend 1 day a week training in a location close to them, however a training delivery method may be designed to suit the apprentice and the employers' needs

Level 2 will equip apprentices with basic skills in Boat Building. The technical certificate will give apprentices the background knowledge required to gain a sound understanding of their job role and be taught practical skills to enable them to carry out the job effectively.

Level 3 will develop apprentices' skills from Level 2 over a further 2 years to become a qualified and competent Marine Engineer, Boat Builder, Shipwright or Marine Electrician. It may be possible to progress directly onto the Level 3 programme depending on prior experience and qualifications.

Level 2

- Gain a Level 2 Boat Building Apprenticeship over two years
- Achieve a Level 2 NVQ in Boat Building (EAL)
- Achieve a Level 2 Certificate in Boat Building, Maintenance and Support (City & Guilds)
- Achieve Key Skills in Application of Number, Communication and Information Communication Technology Level 1, Working With Others and Improve Own Learning

Level 3

- Gain a Level 3 Boat Building Apprenticeship over two or four years (dependent on entry requirements)
- Achieve a Level 3 NVQ in Boat Building (EAL)
- Achieve a Level 2 and Level 3 Certificate in Boat Building, Maintenance and Support (City & Guilds)
- Achieve Key Skills in Application of Number, Communication and Information Communication Technology Level 2, Working With Others and Improve Own Learning
