**M.D.S. Marine**, I am currently responsible for engine servicing, maintenance, repairs and installation in Commercial, Leisure and Military boats. Recently I have travelled to Kazakhstan; working on a high speed triple engine patrol boat, preparing the boat to be launched involved a third engine and drive being installed from scratch. Working with my work colleague and the local businesses we were able to successfully launch the boat.
