What are NVQ's?

National Vocational Qualifications (NVQs):

- Recognise what a person is able to do at work
- Are based on industry standards, which must be met to be competent in a particular task
- Are very flexible, a candidate doesn't have to start at Level 1 but at the level appropriate to his/her job and abilities
- Qualifications are made up of a number of nationally recognised units
- Are gained when all the assessment routes have been achieved
