



## Train 2 Gain

### What is Train 2 Gain?



Train 2 Gain is an initiative to raise the skill levels of people who are in work but do not already hold at least one Level 2 qualification. The aim of the initiative is to have all skilled employees trained to a minimum of a Level 2 certificate.

#### Guidance will be given to help you:

- Identify your skills need
- Pinpoint the right training
- Agree a tailored training package
- Find available funding
- Review the progress you are making

### Funding

Funding is available to help with the cost of you achieving your NVQ. The employer is required to make a one-off contribution towards the cost of the training.

Using CMN's unique funding package we can help subsidise the employer's contribution and look into wage subsidies and any travel costs.

### What is the eligibility criteria?

- You must be over the age of 19
- Be a British citizen or resident in the EU in the last 3 years
- You should not already have a Level 2 qualification, or the equivalent, which is five GCSEs at grades A to C

### What training can I do?

You can undertake a National Vocational Qualification (NVQ) in your workplace and be assigned an assessor to mentor you through your qualification. See CMN fact sheet on NVQs for a list of what we can offer.

### After achieving your NVQ...

After gaining your NVQ, you'll be able to:

- Go on to the next level qualification
- Put the recognised skills to use within your company
